ASSISTED SUICIDE BILL: There's still time to fill out your postcard to register your objection with our parliamentarians about the forthcoming Assisted Suicide bill. They're at the back of church and only take a couple of minutes to fill in. The reading last year passed with only a slim majority of 55 with 330 ayes and 275 noes. As several MPs that we know of voted 'aye' on the condition that appropriate safeguards were in place, the fact that the safeguards have been loosened already by replacing the approval of 2 judges with a 'panel' could be enough to tip the balance.
